AN ACT

CONCERNING QUALIFICATIONS FOR EMPLOYMENT BY THE DIVISION OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 8-47-204, Colorado Revised Statutes, 1986 Repl. Vol., as amended, is amended to read:

8-47-204. Employees of division - qualifications. The executive director has the power to employ, pursuant to section 13 of article XII of the state constitution, such deputies, experts, statisticians, accountants, inspectors, clerks, and other employees as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of articles 40 to 47 of this title or to perform the duties and exercise the powers conferred by law upon the division. ~~Such deputies, statisticians, accountants, inspectors, clerks, and other employees, except experts in the employ of the division, shall have been for two years prior to such employment or appointment bona fide residents of the state of Colorado, and all of them, except only the experts, while in the employ of the division, shall devote their entire time to the service of the division.~~

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
