AN ACT

**CONCERNING MEALS REQUIRED TO BE SERVED BY A HOLDER OF A HOTEL AND RESTAURANT LICENSE
ISSUED PURSUANT TO THE "COLORADO LIQUOR CODE".**

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 12-47-103 (12) (b), Colorado Revised Statutes, 1991 Repl. Vol.,
is amended to read:

12-47-103. Definitions. (12) (b) ANY HOTEL AND RESTAURANT LICENSEE WHO IS
OPEN FOR BUSINESS AND SELLING MALT, VINOUS, OR SPIRITUOUS LIQUORS BY THE
DRINK SHALL SERVE meals ~~shall be required to be served only~~ between the hours of
8 a.m. and ~~11 p.m.; except that on Sundays and Christmas, meals shall not be~~
~~required to be served after 8 p.m.~~ AND MEALS OR LIGHT SNACKS AND SANDWICHES
AFTER 8 P.M.; EXCEPT THAT NOTHING IN THIS PARAGRAPH (b) SHALL BE CONSTRUED
TO REQUIRE A LICENSEE TO BE OPEN FOR BUSINESS BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 8 A.M.
AND 8 P.M.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and
declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,
health, and safety.
