AN ACT

CONCERNING THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS TO DELEGATE LICENSING FUNCTIONS TO A SUBCOMMITTEE OF BOARD MEMBERS.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 12-36-104, Colorado Revised Statutes, 1991 Repl. Vol., is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SUBSECTION to read:

12-36-104. Powers and duties of board. (3) TO FACILITATE THE LICENSURE OF QUALIFIED APPLICANTS, THE BOARD MAY, IN ITS DISCRETION, ESTABLISH A SUBCOMMITTEE OF AT LEAST THREE BOARD MEMBERS TO PERFORM LICENSING FUNCTIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS ARTICLE. THREE SUBCOMMITTEE MEMBERS SHALL CONSTITUTE A QUORUM OF THE SUBCOMMITTEE. ANY ACTION TAKEN BY A QUORUM OF THE SUBCOMMITTEE SHALL CONSTITUTE ACTION BY THE BOARD.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
