**AN ACT****CONCERNING UNLAWFUL ACTS INVOLVING CERTAIN VEHICLE REGISTRATION MATERIALS.**

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1.** 42-3-133 (1) (b), Colorado Revised Statutes, 1993 Repl. Vol., as amended, is amended to read:

**42-3-133. Violation of registration provisions - penalty.** (1) It is unlawful for any person to commit any of the following acts:

(b) To display or cause or permit to be displayed, ~~or~~ to have in possession, OR TO OFFER FOR SALE any certificate of title, VALIDATION TAB OR STICKER, or registration number plate knowing the same to be fictitious or to have been STOLEN, cancelled, revoked, suspended, or altered;

**SECTION 2. Effective date - applicability.** This act shall take effect July 1, 1995, and shall apply to offenses committed on or after said date.

**SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
