**AN ACT**

**CONCERNING THE TIME PERIOD DURING WHICH THE FIRE AND POLICE PENSION ASSOCIATION IS AUTHORIZED TO INVESTIGATE MEMBERS WHO HAVE BEEN AWARDED DISABILITY BENEFITS BY SAID ASSOCIATION.**

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1.** 31-30-1007 (4) (b), Colorado Revised Statutes, 1986 Repl. Vol., as amended, is amended to read:

**31-30-1007. Retirement for disability.** (4) (b) The board shall have the authority to investigate claims for disability retirement benefits at the time of initial application for benefits or subsequent to an award of benefits in order to determine eligibility or continuing eligibility for such benefits. The board shall appoint such investigators and other personnel as may be necessary to carry out this function. No investigation of a member who has been awarded a disability retirement shall be pursued if more than ~~three~~ FIVE years has elapsed since the date of the award.

**SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
