**AN ACT**

**CONCERNING THE REESTABLISHMENT OF THE VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION ON STATE INCOME TAX RETURNS TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR OLDER AMERICAN VOLUNTEER PROGRAMS.**

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1.** 39-22-1502 (1), Colorado Revised Statutes, 1994 Repl. Vol., is amended to read:

**39-22-1502. Voluntary contribution designation - procedure.** (1) For income tax years commencing on or after January 1, ~~1993~~ 1996, but prior to January 1, ~~1996~~ 1999, each Colorado state individual income tax return form shall contain a line whereby each individual taxpayer may designate the amount of the contribution, if any, such individual wishes to make to the action older American volunteer program fund created in section 39-22-1503.

**SECTION 2.** 39-22-1504, Colorado Revised Statutes, 1994 Repl. Vol., is amended to read:

**39-22-1504. Repeal of part.** This part 15 is repealed, effective January 1, ~~1997~~ 2000.

**SECTION 3. Effective date.** This act shall take effect January 1, 1996.

**SECTION 4. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
