ADMINISTRATIVE RULE REVIEW

AN ACT

CONCERNING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL RELATING TO CONTINUATION OF AIR QUALITY STATE IMPLEMENTATION PLANS AND RELATED RULES OF THE AIR QUALITY CONTROL COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. State implementation plans and rules scheduled for expiration May 15, 1996 - extension. Except as otherwise specifically provided in this act, the expiration of all state implementation plans and revisions and related rules contained in this act of the air quality control commission, which state implementation plans and revisions and related rules contained in this act were adopted or amended by the commission on or after January 1, 1995, and before November 1, 1995, and which were therefore scheduled for expiration May 15, 1996, is postponed until May 15, 2003, and the provisions of section 24-4-108, Colorado Revised Statutes, shall apply.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
