AN ACT

**CONCERNING THE ALLOCATION FOR ART REQUIREMENT FOR CERTAIN YOUTH SERVICE FACILITIES
UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES.**

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 24-80.5-101 (3) (a), Colorado Revised Statutes, 1988 Repl. Vol., as amended, is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SUBPARAGRAPH to read:

24-80.5-101. Works of art in public places - allocations therefor from capital construction costs - guidelines - fund created. (3) (a) (IV) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH (a), THE PERCENTAGE OF THE CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION COSTS FOR THE JUVENILE DETENTION AND JUVENILE COMMITMENT BEDS AUTHORIZED BY SECTIONS 15 AND 16 OF HOUSE BILL 94-1340, ENACTED AT THE SECOND REGULAR SESSION OF THE FIFTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY, AND SECTIONS 25, 26, AND 27 OF HOUSE BILL 95-1352, ENACTED AT THE FIRST REGULAR SESSION OF THE SIXTIETH GENERAL ASSEMBLY, ALLOCATED TO ACQUISITION OF WORKS OF ART SHALL BE ONE-TENTH OF ONE PERCENT. IT IS THE INTENT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THAT THESE ALLOCATIONS BE UTILIZED TO ACQUIRE ARTWORKS PRODUCED BY RESIDENTS OF THE STATE'S JUVENILE FACILITIES.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
