AN ACT

**CONCERNING CLARIFICATION OF THE EXEMPTION OF FUGITIVE DUST FROM FEES PURSUANT TO THE
"COLORADO AIR POLLUTION PREVENTION AND CONTROL ACT".**

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 25-7-114.7 (1) (b) (II), Colorado Revised Statutes, 1989 Repl. Vol.,
as amended, is amended to read:

25-7-114.7. Emission fees - fund - repeal. (1) As used in this section, unless the
context otherwise requires:

(b) (II) The term "regulated pollutant", FOR THE PURPOSE OF ASSESSING FEES, shall
not include fugitive dust or fugitive emissions as defined in commission rule I.B.1 of
regulation number 3, 5 CCR 1001-5 OR ANY FRACTION THEREOF.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and
declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,
health, and safety.
