AN ACT

CONCERNING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. The headnotes (1) (c) and (1) (e) to section 3 and Part V (16), Part VI (2)(B), Part VIII (2), and Part XI (B) and the affected totals of section 3 of chapter 283, Session Laws of Colorado 1995, are amended, and the said section 3 and the affected totals of said section 3 are further amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SUBSECTION TO PART VI AND BY THE ADDITION OF THE FOLLOWING NEW PARTS, to read:

Section 3. **Capital construction appropriation.** (1) (c) In addition to any other appropriation made for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1995, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, to the capital construction fund created in section 24-75-302, Colorado Revised Statutes, the sum of ~~four hundred eighty-two thousand eight hundred sixty-two dollars (\$482,862)~~ FIFTY SEVEN MILLION THREE HUNDRED EIGHTEEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$57,318,645).

(e) Moneys appropriated in this section from the capital construction fund include the sum of fifty million dollars (\$50,000,000) transferred from the general fund to the capital construction fund pursuant to section 24-75-302, Colorado Revised Statutes, which sum constitutes state fiscal year spending as defined in section 24-77-102 (17) (a), Colorado Revised Statutes, ~~four hundred eighty-two thousand eight hundred sixty-two dollars (\$482,862)~~ FIFTY SEVEN MILLION THREE HUNDRED EIGHTEEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$57,318,645) appropriated from the general fund to the capital construction fund pursuant to paragraph (c) of this subsection (1), and thirteen million five hundred seventy-six thousand four hundred dollars (\$13,576,400) in interest and unexpended and unencumbered moneys in the capital construction fund pursuant to section 24-75-302 (1), Colorado Revised Statutes, which sums do not constitute state fiscal year spending as defined in section 24-77-102 (17) (b), Colorado Revised Statutes.

(I) SECTION 7 OF ARTICLE XI OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION PROVIDES THAT NOTHING IN THE STATE CONSTITUTION SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO PREVENT THE STATE FROM GIVING DIRECT FINANCIAL SUPPORT TO ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION AS MAY BE AUTHORIZED BY GENERAL STATUTE;

(II) THE GRAND VALLEY BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES IS AN ENTITY WHOSE MEMBERS ARE ALL EITHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS OF THE STATE OR STATE AGENCIES AND ARE THEREFORE AUTHORIZED INDIVIDUALLY TO RECEIVE DIRECT STATE FINANCIAL SUPPORT;

(III) SECTION 22-5-114, COLORADO REVISED STATUTES, AUTHORIZES ANY BOARD OF COOPERATIVE SERVICES THAT IS ORGANIZED PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 5 OF TITLE 22, COLORADO REVISED STATUTES, AND THAT HAS BEEN APPROVED BY THE STATE BOARD TO RECEIVE SUCH STATE MONEYS AS MAY BE MADE AVAILABLE; AND

(IV) THE GRAND VALLEY BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES IS A BOARD OF COOPERATIVE SERVICES ORGANIZED PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 5 OF TITLE 22, COLORADO REVISED STATUTES, AND HAS BEEN APPROVED BY THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

(b) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FURTHER FINDS AND DECLARES THAT A UNIQUE OPPORTUNITY EXISTS FOR THE STATE TO ALLOW MESA STATE COLLEGE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE UNIFIED TECHNICAL EDUCATION CENTER THROUGH THE GRAND VALLEY BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES BY FUNDING MESA STATE COLLEGE'S CONTRIBUTION TO THE GRAND VALLEY BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES.

(c) THEREFORE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY HEREBY DECLARES THAT THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (d) OF THIS SUBSECTION (8) TO THE GRAND VALLEY BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES IS INTENDED TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THIS UNIQUE OPPORTUNITY, IS APPROPRIATE UNDER THE CIRCUMSTANCES, AND IS CONSTITUTIONALLY AND STATUTORILY AUTHORIZED.

(d) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER APPROPRIATION MADE FOR THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR, THERE IS HEREBY APPROPRIATED TO THE GRAND VALLEY BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES THE SUM OF TWO MILLION THREE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,350,000), OR SO MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE NECESSARY, FROM THE CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION FUND CREATED IN SECTION 24-75-302, COLORADO REVISED STATUTES, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF PHASE II OF THE UNIFIED TECHNICAL EDUCATION CENTER OF MESA STATE COLLEGE; EXCEPT THAT THE GRAND VALLEY BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES MUST GIVE SUFFICIENT PROOF THAT ONE MILLION TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,200,000) HAS BEEN RAISED FROM LOCAL SOURCES, INCLUDING GIFTS, GRANTS, OR DONATIONS, BEFORE STATE FUNDS CAN BE ENCUMBERED. EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE OF THIS ACT, NO FURTHER APPROPRIATION OF STATE FUNDS SHALL BE REQUESTED OR AUTHORIZE FOR THIS PROJECT.

(9.5) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER APPROPRIATION MADE FOR THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR, THERE IS HEREBY APPROPRIATED TO THE STATE BOARD FOR COMMUNITY COLLEGES AND OCCUPATIONAL EDUCATION, THE SUM OF FOUR MILLION TWO HUNDRED FORTY-NINE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED FORTY DOLLARS (\$4,249,540), OR SO MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE NECESSARY, FOR ADDITIONS AND RENOVATIONS TO BUILDING A AT THE LARIMER CAMPUS OF THE FRONT RANGE COMMUNITY COLLEGE. OF SAID SUM, TWO MILLION TWO HUNDRED FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,215,000) SHALL BE FROM THE CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION FUND CREATED IN SECTION 24-75-302, COLORADO REVISED STATUTES, NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED, AND TWO MILLION THIRTY-FOUR THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED FORTY DOLLARS (\$2,034,540) SHALL BE FROM CASH FUNDS CONSISTING OF GIFTS, GRANTS, AND DONATIONS.

SECTION 7. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the

public peace, health, and safety.
