AN ACT

CONCERNING THE REPEAL OF PROVISIONS CONTROLLING LOCAL EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 25-3.5-607, Colorado Revised Statutes, 1989 Repl. Vol., as amended, is repealed as follows:

25-3.5-607. Repeal of part. ~~Unless continued by the general assembly, this part 6 is repealed, effective July 1, 1997.~~

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
