MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC REGULATION

SENATE BILL 96-057

BY SENATORS Schaffer, Blickensderfer, and Tebedo;
also REPRESENTATIVE Jerke.**AN ACT****CONCERNING MANAGEMENT OF THE DISTRIBUTIVE DATA PROCESSING SYSTEM.***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

SECTION 1. The introductory portion to 42-1-211 (1) and 42-1-211 (4) (a), Colorado Revised Statutes, 1993 Repl. Vol., as amended, are amended to read:

42-1-211. Distributive data processing system. (1) The department is hereby authorized to ~~develop and manage~~ COORDINATE THE MANAGEMENT OF a statewide distributive data processing system. This system is to provide the necessary data processing equipment, ~~and~~ software, AND SUPPORT AND TRAINING to:

(4) (a) There is hereby created the distributive data processing advisory committee comprised of ~~six~~ SEVEN authorized agents who MUST BE COUNTY CLERK AND RECORDERS OR THE MANAGER OF REVENUE FOR THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER AND shall be appointed by the executive director of the department. The committee shall:

(I) ASSIST IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF ANNUAL OPERATIONAL PLANS AND BUDGET PROPOSALS REGARDING THE DISTRIBUTIVE DATA PROCESSING SYSTEM AND THE SPECIAL PURPOSE ACCOUNT;

(II) ~~approve~~ GIVE FINAL APPROVAL OF ALL plans for the development and operation of the distributive data processing system AND THE ANNUAL BUDGET AND ANY SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET REQUESTS FUNDED BY THE SPECIAL PURPOSE ACCOUNT; AND

(III) MAKE PRESENTATIONS WITH THE DEPARTMENT TO THE APPROPRIATE LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEES REGARDING THE USE OF FUNDS IN THE SPECIAL PURPOSE

Capital letters indicate new material added to existing statutes; dashes through words indicate deletions from existing statutes and such material not part of act.

ACCOUNT.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
