**AN ACT**

**CONCERNING THE SUNSET DATE FOR THE REGULATION OF FIREWORKS, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, REPEALING THE STATUTORY PROVISIONS THAT TERMINATE FIREWORKS REGULATION ON JULY 1, 1996.**

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1.** 12-28-112, Colorado Revised Statutes, 1991 Repl. Vol., as amended, is repealed as follows:

**12-28-112. Repeal of article.** ~~This article is repealed, effective July 1, 1996. Prior to such repeal the licensing functions of the executive director of the department of public safety shall be reviewed as provided for in section 24-34-104, C.R.S.~~

**SECTION 2.** 24-34-104 (25.1) (1), Colorado Revised Statutes, 1988 Repl. Vol., as amended, is repealed as follows:

**24-34-104. General assembly review of regulatory agencies and functions for termination, continuation, or reestablishment.** (25.1) The following functions of the specified agencies shall terminate on July 1, 1996:

(1) ~~The licensing functions relating to fireworks of the executive director of the department of public safety in accordance with article 28 of title 12, C.R.S.~~

**SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
