AN ACT

CONCERNING A DEFINITION OF "FARM" FOR PURPOSES OF DETERMINING "FARM LABOR" UNDER
THE LABOR PEACE ACT.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 8-3-104 (11), Colorado Revised Statutes, 1986 Repl. Vol., is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW PARAGRAPH to read:

8-3-104. Definitions. As used in this article, unless the context otherwise requires:

(11) (f) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION (11), "FARM" MEANS STOCK, DAIRY, POULTRY, FUR-BEARING ANIMAL, AND TRUCK FARMS, PLANTATIONS, RANCHES, NURSERIES, RANGES, GREENHOUSES, ORCHARDS, AND OTHER STRUCTURES USED FOR THE RAISING OF AGRICULTURAL OR HORTICULTURAL COMMODITIES, PROVIDED SUCH STRUCTURES ARE UTILIZED FOR AT LEAST FIFTY PERCENT OF THE TOTAL OUTPUT PRODUCED.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
