AN ACT

CONCERNING CONTINUED FREE ENTRANCE TO STATE PARKS AND RECREATION FACILITIES FOR DISABLED VETERANS WHOSE VEHICLES DISPLAY A COLORADO DISABLED VETERAN'S LICENSE PLATE.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 33-12-106 (2), Colorado Revised Statutes, 1995 Repl. Vol., is repealed as follows:

33-12-106. Park entrance privileges - identified veterans. (2) ~~This section is repealed, effective July 1, 1997.~~

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
