**EDUCATION - PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

**AN ACT**

CONCERNING EDUCATION REFORM BY REPEALING THE REPEALER FOR THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO WAIVE ANY REQUIREMENTS OF TITLE 22, COLORADO REVISED STATUTES, FOR THE PURPOSES OF ENHANCING EDUCATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1. Repeal.** 22-2-117 (4), Colorado Revised Statutes, is repealed as followed:

**22-2-117. Additional power - state board - waiver of requirements.** (4) ~~This section is repealed, effective July 1, 1998.~~

**SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
