AN ACT

CONCERNING THE REPEAL OF THE REQUIREMENT THAT AN ARCHITECT'S LICENSE NUMBER BE INCLUDED
IN ADVERTISING.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. Repeal. 12-4-115 (3), Colorado Revised Statutes, is repealed as follows:

12-4-115. Use of title. (3) ~~Any listing or advertisement by an architect in any Colorado publication shall include the Colorado license number of the architect.~~

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
