AN ACT

CONCERNING THE REPEAL OF THE MAGNET SCHOOL PLANNING BOARD.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. Repeal. 2-3-1203 (3) (m) (I), Colorado Revised Statutes, is repealed as follows:

2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees. (3) The following dates are the dates for which the statutory authorization for the designated advisory committees is scheduled for repeal:

(m) July 1, 2000:

(I) ~~The magnet school planning board for the Colorado magnet school for mathematics, science, and technology created in section 22-84-102, C.R.S.;~~

SECTION 2. Repeal. Article 84 of title 22, Colorado Revised Statutes, is repealed.

SECTION 3. Effective date. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000.

SECTION 4. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
