also SENATOR(S) McElhany.**AN ACT****CONCERNING MEASURES THAT WILL ADDRESS WHETHER ALL ACCOUNTS FOR ALCOHOL BEVERAGES SOLD TO THE APPLICANT ARE PAID WHEN APPLYING FOR A TEMPORARY PERMIT PENDING TRANSFER OF CERTAIN ALCOHOL LICENSES.***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:***SECTION 1.** 12-47-303 (3), Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW PARAGRAPH to read:**12-47-303. Transfer of ownership and temporary permits.** (3) A temporary permit shall authorize a transferee to conduct business and sell alcohol beverages at retail in accordance with the license of the transferor subject to compliance with all of the following conditions:

(d) WHEN APPLYING WITH THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY FOR A TEMPORARY PERMIT, THE APPLICANT SHALL PROVIDE A COPY, BY FACSIMILE OR OTHERWISE, OF THE STATEMENT MADE PURSUANT TO SUBPARAGRAPH (V) OF PARAGRAPH (b) OF THIS SUBSECTION (3) TO THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY. SUCH STATEMENT IS A PUBLIC RECORD AND SHALL BE OPEN TO INSPECTION BY THE PUBLIC.

SECTION 2. Effective date - applicability. This act shall take effect July 1, 2002, and shall apply to applications made on or after said date.**SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
