AN ACT

CONCERNING THE APPLICATION OF THE STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS FOR PROSECUTING OFFENSES BASED ON A SERIES OF ACTS PERFORMED AT DIFFERENT TIMES TO CRIMINAL VIOLATIONS UNDER THE "COLORADO SECURITIES ACT".

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 16-5-401 (4), Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

16-5-401. Limitation for commencing criminal proceedings and juvenile delinquency proceedings. (4) When an offense or delinquent act is based on a series of acts performed at different times, the period of limitation prescribed by this code OR BY THE "COLORADO SECURITIES ACT", ARTICLE 51 OF TITLE 11, C.R.S., starts at the time when the last act in the series of acts is committed.

SECTION 2. Effective date - applicability. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003, and shall apply to offenses committed on or after said date.

SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
