AN ACT

CONCERNING THE "CHILD MENTAL HEALTH TREATMENT ACT".

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 27-10.3-108, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

27-10.3-108. Repeal of article. This article is repealed, effective July 1, ~~2003~~ 2004.

SECTION 2. Effective date. This act shall take effect upon passage, only if Senate Bill 03-282, enacted at the First Regular Session of the Sixty-fourth General Assembly, is enacted and becomes law and said Senate Bill 03-282 includes funding for the provision of mental health services pursuant to article 10.3 of title 27, Colorado Revised Statutes, in an amount equal to the final fiscal estimate for this act.

SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
