MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC REGULATION

AN ACT

CONCERNING THE MAXIMUM GROSS WEIGHT OF A VEHICLE COMBINATION OPERATED BY AN ELECTRIC UTILITY.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 42-4-507 (2) (b.5), Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

42-4-507. Wheel and axle loads. (2) The gross weight upon any single axle or tandem axle of a vehicle shall not exceed the following:

(b.5) When the wheels attached to a single axle are equipped with pneumatic tires and the vehicle OR VEHICLE COMBINATION is a digger derrick or bucket boom truck operated by an electric utility on a highway that is not on the interstate system as defined in section 43-2-101 (2), C.R.S., twenty-one thousand pounds;

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
