AN ACT**CONCERNING THE REPEAL OF TRANSFERS TO THE CONTROLLED MAINTENANCE TRUST FUND.**

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. Repeal. 24-75-302.5 (3) (b), Colorado Revised Statutes, is repealed as follows:

24-75-302.5. Controlled maintenance - trust fund. (3) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section to the contrary:

(b) ~~(i) On July 1, 2004, the state treasurer and the controller shall transfer an amount equal to one hundred thirty-eight million two hundred thousand dollars from the general fund to the trust fund.~~

~~(ii) On July 1, 2005, the state treasurer and the controller shall transfer an amount equal to one hundred thirty-eight million two hundred thousand dollars from the general fund to the trust fund.~~

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
