AN ACT

CONCERNING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATURE.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. Part XI of section 2 of chapter 427, Session Laws of Colorado 2004, is amended to read:

Section 2. **Appropriation.**

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
