AN ACT

**CONCERNING THE ADDITION OF THE STATE TREASURER AS A NONVOTING MEMBER OF THE
COVERCOLORADO BOARD OF DIRECTORS.**

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 10-8-505 (3), Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

10-8-505. Board of directors. (3) The commissioner or his or her designee, THE STATE TREASURER OR HIS OR HER DESIGNEE, and a member of the general assembly shall serve as ex officio nonvoting members of the board. The initial appointee of the general assembly shall be a member of the senate appointed by the president of the senate, the next appointee shall be a member of the house of representatives appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives, and thereafter such appointment shall rotate in like manner between the senate and the house of representatives.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
