AN ACT

CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF THE REGULATION OF WHOLESALE FOOD MANUFACTURERS BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT, AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION THEREFOR.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 25-5-426 (6), Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

- **25-5-426.** Wholesale food manufacturing and storage definitions legislative declaration fees cash fund repeal. (6) This section is repealed, effective July 1, 2007 2017.
- **SECTION 2. Appropriation.** In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the wholesale food manufacturing and storage protection cash fund created in section 25-5-426 (5), Colorado Revised Statutes, not otherwise appropriated, to the department of public health and environment, for allocation to the consumer protection division, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, the sum of one hundred seventy-four thousand nine hundred thirty-two dollars (\$174,932) and 1.5 FTE, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the implementation of this act.
- **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
