**AN ACT**

**CONCERNING THE REPEAL OF THE CASINO EXEMPTION FROM THE "COLORADO CLEAN INDOOR AIR ACT".**

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1. Repeal.** 25-14-205 (1) (j), Colorado Revised Statutes, is repealed as follows:

**25-14-205. Exceptions to smoking restrictions.** (1) This part 2 shall not apply to:

(j) ~~The retail floor plan, as defined in section 12-47.1-509, C.R.S., of a licensed casino.~~

**SECTION 2. Effective date.** This act shall take effect at 8 a.m. on January 1, 2008.

**SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
