MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC REGULATION

AN ACT**CONCERNING THE LADEN STATUS OF A TRUCK TRAILER THAT IS NOT CARRYING CARGO.**

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 42-1-102 (109) and (109.5), Colorado Revised Statutes, are amended to read:

42-1-102. Definitions. As used in articles 1 to 4 of this title, unless the context otherwise requires:

(109) "Truck tractor - laden" or "laden truck tractor" means any motor vehicle carrying cargo ~~or designed to carry cargo~~ that is generally and commonly designed and used to draw, AND IS DRAWING, a semitrailer or trailer and its cargo load over the public highways.

(109.5) "Truck tractor - unladen" or "unladen truck tractor" means any motor vehicle not carrying cargo that is generally ~~and commonly designed and~~ used to draw a semitrailer or trailer and its cargo load over the public highways.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
