AN ACT**CONCERNING THE REPEAL OF FEES IMPOSED ON THE AUTHORIZATION TO USE PARKING PRIVILEGES OF PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES.**

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. Repeal. 42-3-204 (2) (e), Colorado Revised Statutes, is repealed as follows:

42-3-204. Parking privileges for persons with disabilities - applicability.
(2) (e) ~~The department shall establish a fee for any placard issued pursuant to paragraph (c) of this subsection (2). The fee established by the department shall not exceed the actual costs of issuing the placards, and the moneys collected by the department shall be transmitted to the state treasurer, who shall credit such moneys to the highway users tax fund for allocation and expenditure as specified in section 43-4-205 (5.5) (b), C.R.S.~~

SECTION 2. Effective date. This act shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly that is allowed for submitting a referendum petition pursuant to article V, section 1 (3) of the state constitution, (August 6, 2008, if adjournment sine die is on May 7, 2008); except that, if a referendum petition is filed against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part, if approved by the people, shall take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by proclamation of the governor.
