TRANSPORTATION

SENATE BILL 08-012

AN ACT

CONCERNING THE REPEAL OF THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE GOVERNOR CONSIDER APPOINTING TO
THE TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION ONE OR MORE INDIVIDUALS WITH KNOWLEDGE OR
EXPERIENCE IN AVIATION.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 43-1-106 (4) (c), Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

43-1-106. Transportation commission - powers and duties. (4) (c) As the terms of the members of the commission expire, the governor shall consider the appointment to the commission of one or more individuals with knowledge or experience in ~~aviation or~~ mass transportation in order to provide for a commission with expertise in ~~all~~ DIFFERENT modes of transportation and shall consider the appointment to the commission of at least one individual with knowledge or experience in engineering.

SECTION 2. Effective date. This act shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly that is allowed for submitting a referendum petition pursuant to article V, section 1 (3) of the state constitution, (August 6, 2008, if adjournment sine die is on May 7, 2008); except that, if a referendum petition is filed against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part, if approved by the people, shall take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by proclamation of the governor.
