**AN ACT**

**CONCERNING THE REPEAL OF PROVISIONS REQUIRING A CUMULATIVE ECONOMIC ANALYSIS OF  
STATE AIR QUALITY CONTROL MEASURES EVERY FIVE YEARS.**

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1. Repeal.** 25-7-110.5 (4) (d), Colorado Revised Statutes, is repealed as follows:

**25-7-110.5. Required analysis of proposed air quality rules.**  
(4) (d) ~~Cumulative economic analyses of all air pollution control measures shall be performed by the executive director of the department of public health and environment after public comment and review. The cumulative economic analyses shall be performed every five years beginning July 1, 2008.~~

**SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
