AN ACT

CONCERNING THE ELIMINATION OF THE REPEAL OF CERTAIN PROVISIONS REQUIRING THAT THE COLORADO BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION DENY THE TRANSFER OF A FIREARM TO A PERSON IF THE BUREAU RECEIVES CERTAIN INFORMATION ABOUT THE PERSON'S CRIMINAL HISTORY IN RESPONSE TO A SEARCH OF A CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS DATABASE.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. Repeal. 24-33.5-424 (3) (b) (II), Colorado Revised Statutes, is repealed as follows:

24-33.5-424. National instant criminal background check system - state point of contact - grounds for denial of firearm transfer - appeal - rule-making - unlawful acts. (3) (b) (II) ~~This paragraph (b) shall be repealed, effective July 1, 2010.~~

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
