AN ACT

CONCERNING AN EXEMPTION TO THE "UNCLAIMED PROPERTY ACT" FOR FUNDS HELD IN CERTAIN LAWYER TRUST ACCOUNTS.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 38-13-102, add (8.1) as follows:

- **38-13-102. Definitions and use of terms.** As used in this article, unless the context otherwise requires:
- (8.1) "Lawyer COLTAF trust account" means a Colorado Lawyer trust account foundation trust account in which a lawyer, in accordance with the lawyer's professional obligations, holds funds of clients or third persons that are nominal in amount or that are expected to be held for a short period.
 - **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 38-13-108.3 as follows:
- **38-13-108.3. Funds held in lawyer COLTAF trust accounts exemption.** This article does not apply to funds held in lawyer COLTAF trust accounts.
- **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
