Revisor of Statutes:

Pursuant to §39-22-1001(8)(b), C.R.S., the Department of Revenue hereby advises the Revisor of Statutes that the 2022 Colorado Individual Income Tax Return shall provide no more than 20 lines for voluntary contributions to the following charitable organizations. 16. Donate to a Colorado Nonprofit Fund
