
Our mission is to increase access, affordability and choice for individuals, families and small employers purchasing health insurance in Colorado.

Financial Help

Depending on factors including **family size** and **annual income**, Coloradans may be eligible for financial help in two forms:



1. Lower Monthly Premiums


"Premium Tax Credits" help pay for your monthly premium.

2. Lower Health Bills

"Cost-Sharing Reductions" reduce the cost of copays, deductibles, coinsurance, and out-of-pocket-maximums in Silver-level plans.



Enrollment Assistance

We offer free enrollment assistance across the state, and people are using it to get covered. We have 919 Brokers and Assisters helping people enroll.

- Broker-supported Enrollments: Up 23% YoY
- Assister-supported Enrollments: Up 8% YoY
- 55% of enrollments completed through a certified Broker or Assister

Green = Enrollment Centers


Blue = Health Coverage Guides

Strategic Plan 2021-2024

Our strategic goals guide our work and move forward our mission:

- Advocate to improve access to coverage in areas of rural Colorado.
- Maximize the number of consumers and employers who shop and enroll through the health insurance marketplace and apply for financial assistance.
- 3. Improve the ability of customers to attain and retain the right coverage for their needs.
- 4. Ensure that Connect for Health Colorado is a healthy and thriving organization.



- 19 Enrollment Center locations in rural and frontier areas, 4 new this year.
 - Virtual enrollment options reduce travel times and make appointments more accessible.
 - 29% of Enrollment Center business was from rural communities
 - 87% of rural Enrollment Center customers received financial help
- Only one Colorado county (Jackson) has a single issuer in 2022.
- Added a new staff position to focus on Southern Colorado Outreach, leading to 16 new community partnerships.

2022 Open Enrollment Report




- 198,412 Coloradans enrolled in a health plan during Open Enrollment
 - 52,101 rural enrollments, average net premium with financial help: \$129/month
 - 146,311 urban enrollments, average net premium with financial help: \$123/month
- 75% of customers received financial help
- Average premium for customers not receiving financial help: \$387/month
- \$28 decrease in monthly net premium from last year
- 56,718 Coloradans enrolled in a dental plan during Open Enrollment

Customer Service Improvements: Open Enrollment


- 2022 Customer Service Center wait time: 15 seconds

 CHP+



Health Care Coverage Easy (Tax Time) Enrollment Program

- The <u>Health Care Coverage Easy</u>
 <u>Enrollment Program</u> (HB20-1236)
 connects uninsured Coloradans to free or low-cost health coverage using their Colorado state tax return.
 - Rebranded as "Tax Time Enrollment" for clarity
- 2022 Tax Time Special Enrollment Period concluded April 15th.

Health Insurance Affordability Enterprise (HIAE)

Funding and direction from the <u>Health Insurance Affordability Enterprise</u> (Senate Bill 20-215) and its <u>Board of Directors</u> shapes **our ability to provide coverage and financial help to thousands more Coloradans.**

- During the last Open Enrollment for Plan Year 2022, Connect for Health Colorado provided
 25,000+ <u>customers with a certain income and who enroll in a silver plan with richer plan benefits</u>. This
 program made possible by HIAE helps customers better afford to use their plan and access health care
 services.
- During next Open Enrollment for Plan Year 2023, we'll be able to offer plans to people who are unable to
 obtain coverage or savings under current Affordable Care Act rules. People who cannot afford to cover their
 family through their employer's health plan, and people who are undocumented, will be eligible for plans
 and savings on Colorado Connect, Connect for Health Colorado's public benefit corporation.



End of the Public Health Emergency

At the end of the federal Public Health Emergency, HCPF will begin Medicaid and CHP+ redeterminations over the course of 14 months. We expect between 3,000-10,000 enrollees in Marketplace coverage.

Member receives their letter telling them that they are no longer eligible for Health First Colorado or CHP+ and encouraging them to apply with ConnectforHealthCO.com

During their 60-day Special Enrollment Period, member applies with Connect for Health Colorado on their own or with a Broker or Assister Member selects a health insurance plan and/or dental plan, and their coverage begins on the first day of the month following plan selection

Member is covered for 2022!
