

- 1% of State Revenue Estimated Expense








### How is Compliance Determined?

Accessibility is determined by testing against the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG). These standards are published by the World Wide Web Consortium (W3C). Sir Tim Berners-Lee, the inventor of the Web, directs this effort.

## Which Conformance Level Do I Need?


