In a letter dated June 25, 2021, you requested that the Office of the State Court Administrator (SCAO) provide the following information:

- •The number of queries made by all members of the General Assembly to the Office of the State Court Administrator on an annual basis.
- •The number of queries made by persons who are not members of the General Assembly to the Office of the State Court Administrator on an annual basis.
- •The number of queries made to the Colorado Judicial Department generally from whatever source on an annual basis.

Based on the language in the letter, along with a follow up conversation I had on June 25 with Bob Lackner from the Office of Legislative Legal Services, I am interpreting your request for the "number of queries" to mean all forms of communication including, but not limited to, phone, e-mail, and in person conversations.

SCAO does not track the inquires made of the office and receives a substantial number of inquiries daily through a variety of communication sources. This issue is only magnified when considering the number of inquiries made daily statewide in the Colorado Judicial Department to courts and probation across 22 judicial districts, over 70 locations and approximately 4,000 employees. For these reasons, we have no records that are responsive to your request. Please feel free to contact me if you have further questions.
