




### Net-Zero Energy Provider by 2050 Goals that cover all the ways our customers use energy

### **RESIDENTIAL BILL NATIONAL COMPARISONS**



Based on 2021 year end results Public Service Colorado had the lowest average residential electric bills among the 50 largest utilities in the US

Public Service also had the 8<sup>th</sup> lowest natural gas bill among the 50 largest gas utilities.


Annual comparisons for 2022 will be available in May 2023.

### Winter 2022-2023 – Bills 58% Lower as Fuel Costs Decrease



Interim or out of cycle GCA reductions saved customers an average of \$34 in December, \$20 in February, and \$12 in March.


