## **Fiscal Summary of Initiative 202**

This fiscal summary, prepared by the nonpartisan Director of Research of the Legislative Council, contains a preliminary assessment of the measure's fiscal impact. A full fiscal impact statement for this initiative is or will be available at **leg.colorado.gov/bluebook**. This fiscal summary identifies the following impact.

**State revenue and expenditures.** This measure further codifies the ability of a candidate to access a ballot in Colorado through the caucus and assembly process of a political party. As this is the current practice, there is not estimated to be an increase to state revenue or expenditures.

**Local government impact.** Local municipalities and counties will continue to use their current voting processes and have no additional cost to comply with this measure.

**Economic impacts.** The measure has no direct impact on the state economy.
