Fiscal Summary of Initiative 206

This fiscal summary, prepared by the nonpartisan Director of Research of the Legislative Council, contains a preliminary assessment of the measure's fiscal impact. A full fiscal impact statement for this initiative is or will be available at leg.colorado.gov/bluebook. This fiscal summary identifies the following impact.

State and local government spending. The measure states that a parent of a child in a public school has the right to review their child's public school records within three business days after submitting a request to a public school representative. The measure may increase workload for school districts to establish policies and guidance for records retrieval and distribution, and for the state to provide technical assistance to public schools. Additional staff in school districts may be required to ensure that records are provided within the required time period. The exact impacts cannot be estimated, as they will depend on current school district policies and the number of record requests school districts receive.

Economic impacts. Overall, the measure is not expected to have a direct economic impact on the state.
