REPEAL PROVISIONS IN OPEN MEETINGS LAW APPLICABLE TO LEGISLATIVE LCS TITLE: PROCEEDINGS

Disclaimer. This initial fiscal impact statement has been prepared for an initiative approved for petition circulation by the Secretary of State. If the initiative is placed on the ballot, Legislative Council Staff may revise this estimate for the ballot information booklet (Blue Book) if new information becomes available.

Summary of Measure

Senate Bill 24-157 enacted during the 2024 legislative session, modified the applicability of the Colorado Open Meeting laws to the state legislature. Initiative 287 repeals the provision of SB 24-157, which took effect in March 2024.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

Initiative 287 is assessed as having no fiscal impact. Given that the changes to the applicability of open meeting law to the state legislature in SB 24-157 was assessed as having no fiscal impact, enacting Initiative 287 and repealing these provisions is also estimated to have no impact on state or local government revenue, workload, or expenditures.

Effective Date

If approved by voters at the 2024 general election, this measure takes effect upon proclamation of the Governor, no later than 30 days after the official canvass of the vote is completed.
