

Shall the state consider all fees or monetary amounts collected by government agencies to be taxes. This would require Legislators and Lawyers to comply with the dictionary definition of the word meaning - a charge usually of money imposed by authority on persons or property for public purposes. This would mean that any and all legislation to collect monetary amounts would fall within the TABOR Amendment and require a vote of the people. An example of a fee that was imposed on Colorado residence is the Retail Delivery Fee. Because this bill was classified as a fee the state legislators were allowed to charge every tax payer fees to get the goods and services they require. This proposal means to put an end to this underhanded practice and require transparency between the state and the people that they represent.
