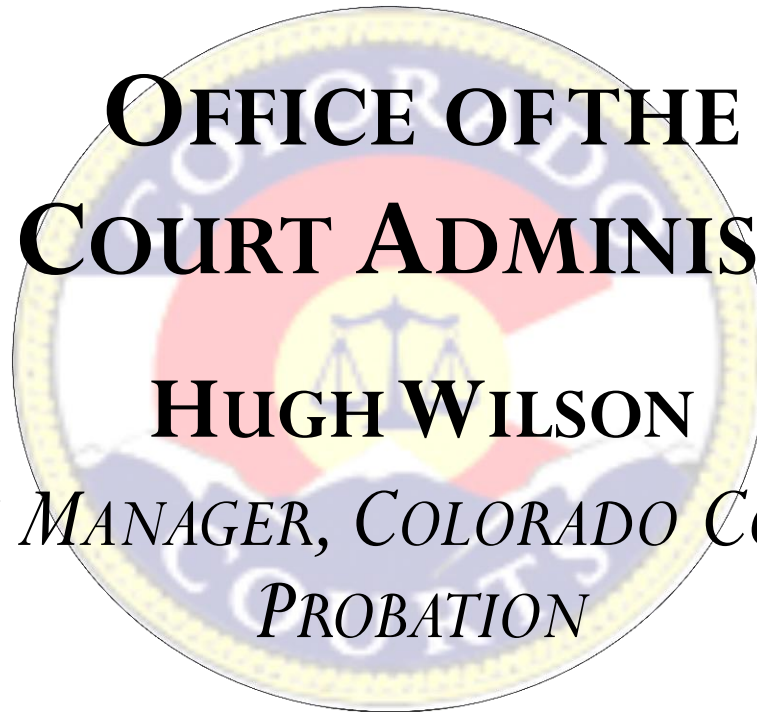

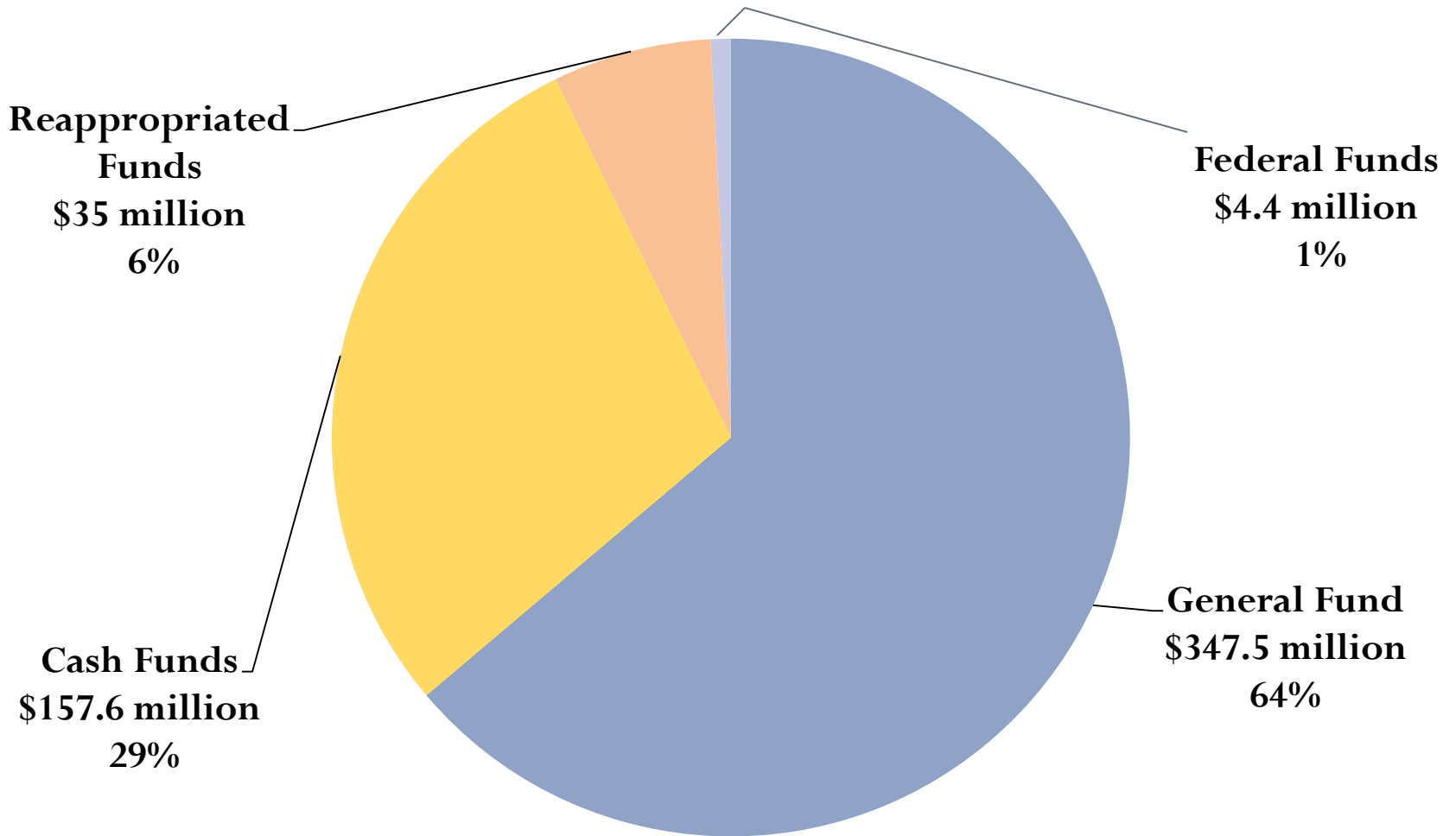
# Fees collected by courts

**Courts and probation collects a variety of fees and fines for judicial and non-judicial agencies.**



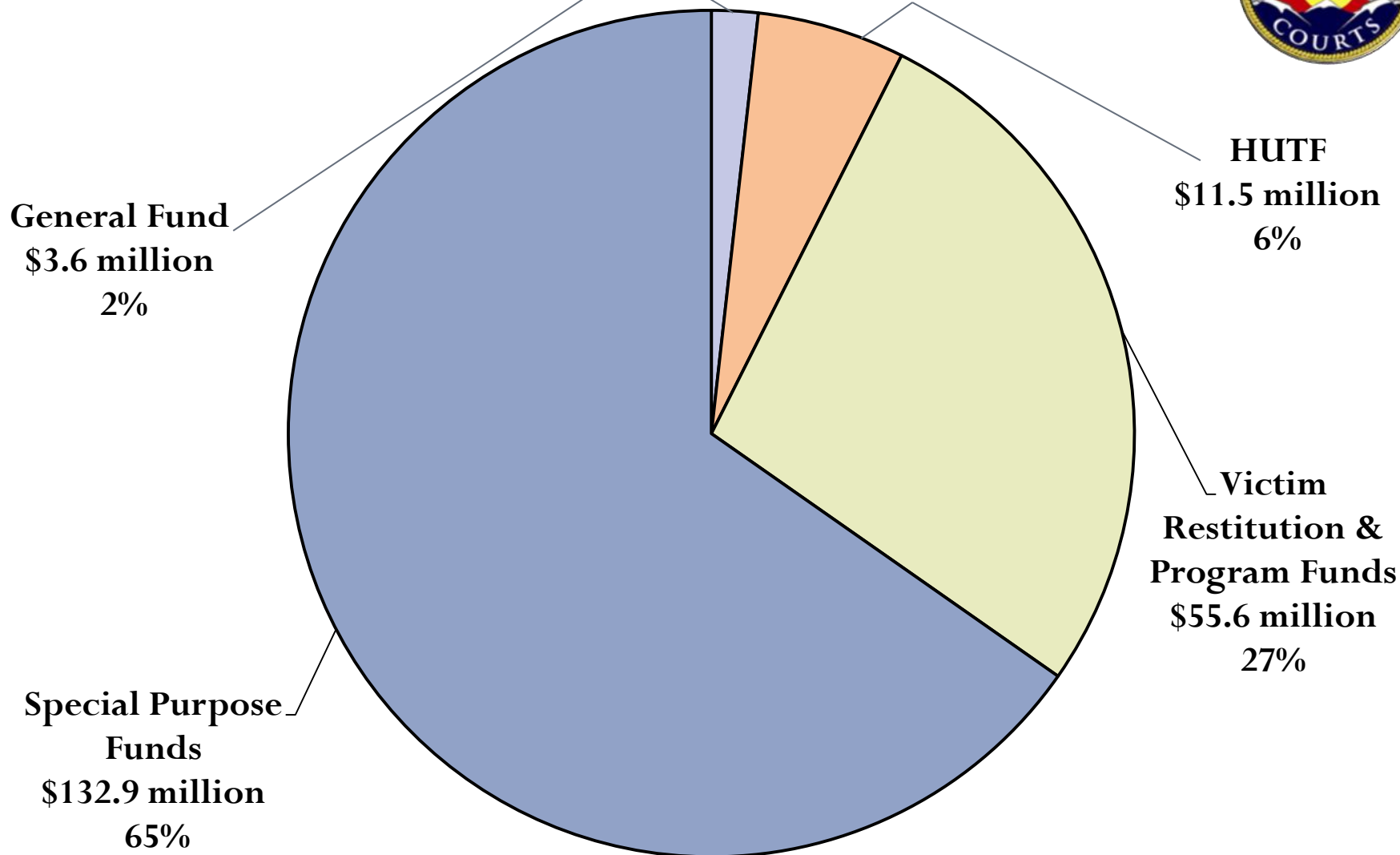
# Judicial fees collected

## **Examples include:**

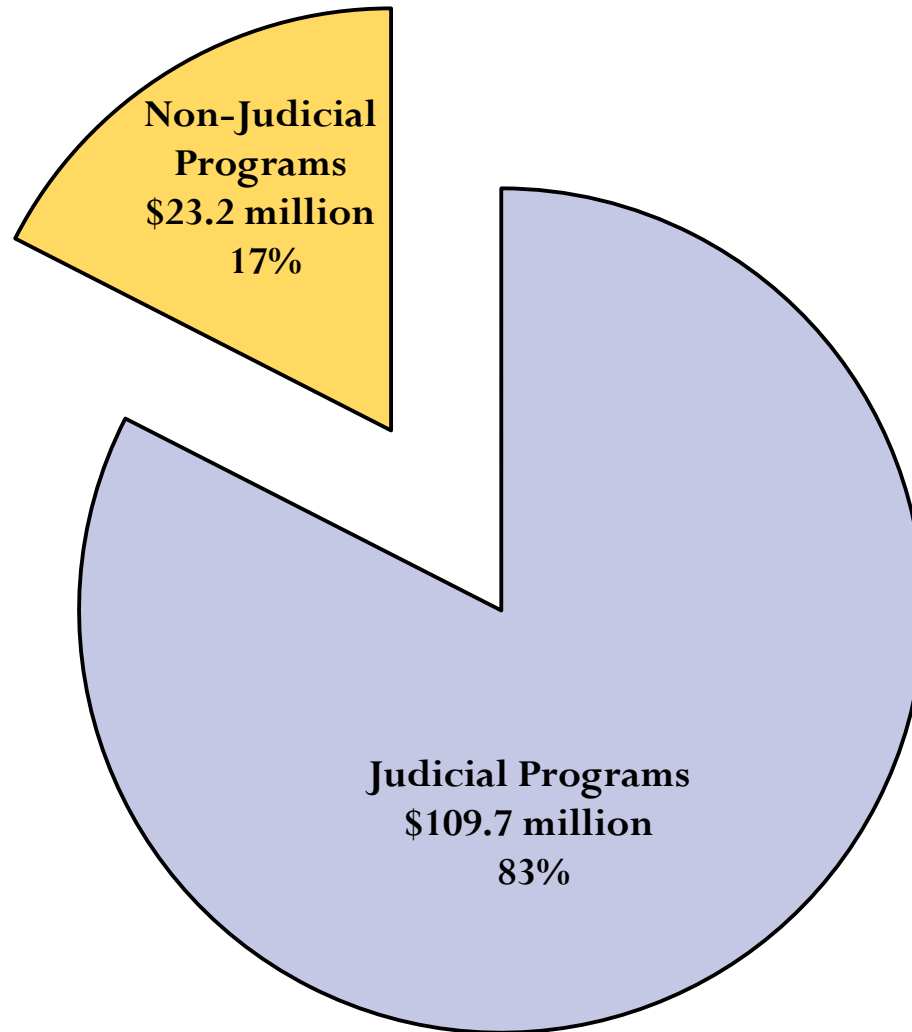
- **Docket fees**

- **Municipal and County Share of Fees and Fines Collected**
- **Colorado Children's Trust Fund**
- **Wildlife Cash Fund**
