

What is Human Trafficking?

- 
- The exploitation of human beings through *force, fraud* or *coercion*, for the purposes of commercial sex or forced labor, wherein a third party is making a profit.

Scope of Trafficking

There are over **40 million** victims of human trafficking globally. *(International Labor Organization)*



Human trafficking happens in **all 50 states**, including D.C. *(National Human Trafficking Resource Center)*



A victim may be forced to have sex up to **20 times** a day. *(Polaris)*



Human trafficking is a **\$150 billion** industry. *(International Labor Organization)*



Thousands of children are at risk of being prostituted in the US each year. *(National Center for Missing and Exploited Children)*

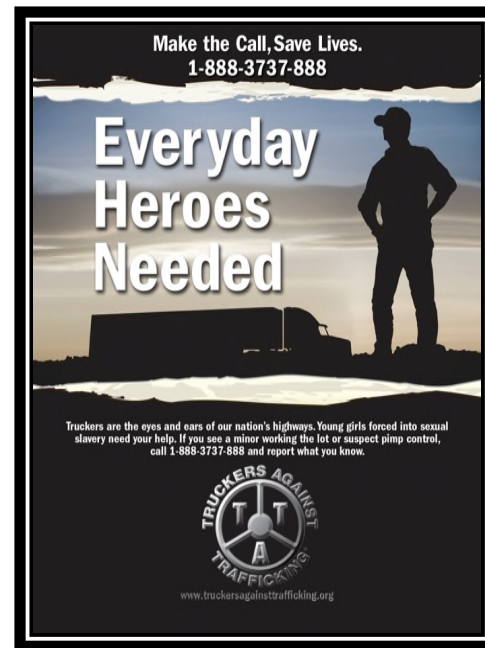

Approaching traffickers is not only dangerous for you and their victims but could lead to problems in the eventual prosecution of traffickers. Also, if at a truck stop/travel plaza, please notify the manager-on-duty of the suspicious activity; she/he needs to be aware of what is taking place on the lot and assist in ending it.

What is human trafficking?

Human trafficking is a worldwide, \$32-billion criminal activity involving hundreds of thousands of victims each year. It is the forced labor and sexual slavery and exploitation through force, fraud or coercion. In this country, between 100,000-300,000 American children are estimated to be at risk of being trafficked annually.

Because this crime depends on the anonymity and carelessness of its victims, traffickers regularly transport and sell them in places they find to be most convenient for them and the easiest to access. Nationwide FBI stops have revealed that truck stops and travel plazas are among these places. Truck stops and travel plazas have been one of the locations from which victims entered into sex trafficking have been rescued and the primary traffickers selling them have been arrested.

Ask yourself!

1. When law enforcement shows up at your establishment for prostitution-related calls?
2. Have you observed minor girls (and maybe boys) as well as women, usually dressed, sitting in or near your reception facilities or getting from truck on the lot?
3. Have you ever seen a car pull into your lot with one male and a number of females who emerge from the car and then begin frequenting the truck?
4. Have you ever seen an adult accompanying a minor into the truck shower area?
5. Do you remember a particular vehicle coming to your lot, dropping off girls and then parking in an area where the car isn't usually used?

If you can answer yes to any of these questions, you may have human trafficking taking place on your lot, where minors for adult women are under the control of a pimp who is selling them for further gain and their exploitation. Please see reference, housing, age, drug, domestic, fraud of all types and other forms of coercive or sexual abuse victims. The average age for a young girl to enter into the sex-for-profit industry in the United States is 13. Any minor engaged in prostitution is not a prostitute, but a trafficking victim, under the control of a trafficker or pimp.
