Dear Senator Winter;

Please accept this correspondence as the vigorous support of the Colorado Snowmobile Association for HB22-1046, as amended. While we had concerns regarding possible impacts to existing access provided under CRS 33-14-110 since 1985 from the original version of this bill, those have been resolved in the amendments undertaken in the House. CSA vigorously supports county concerns about unprepared motor vehicles using roads that are not maintained in the winter time, as often this is a major safety concern and our members participate in these recovery and rescue efforts.

CSA supports the municipalities desire to provide recreational opportunities for all winter recreational users, including motorized users on county roads that are unmaintained. CSA is also aware that many of these unmaintained routes are also providing important access to off grid homes and recreational opportunities on adjacent public lands. These users are aware the road is not maintained and are using the proper equipment to access these areas safely and CSA did not want that access diminished either.
