To whom it may concern,

Thomas de Herrera (DOB: 08/02/1964) is a potential kidney donor undergoing medical and psychosocial testing at Presbyterian/St. Luke's Medical Center (PSLMC) as part of his donor candidacy evaluation. Mr. Herrera has signed the Presbyterian/St. Luke's Transplant Center Living Donor Consent Form which states that *"all pre-transplant donor evaluation costs and hospital charges will be billed to the transplant program, which in turn bills Medicare through the Kidney Acquisition Fund. Any services not covered by Medicare will be billed to the recipient's insurance. This does not include loss of time from work, travel, lodging, and meals prior to and following surgery."*

Presbyterian / St. Luke's admission paperwork does not contain the same language listed on the living donor consent form. This letter is to reaffirm that Mr. de Herrera is not responsible for any charges related to testing and/or treatment related to living kidney donation as stated above.
