**CONCERNING THE APPOINTMENT OF A RESIDENT OF A LOCALITY IN WHICH LIMITED GAMING TAKES PLACE TO THE LIMITED GAMING CONTROL COMMISSION (AS AMENDED).**

**Problem:** Last Two-Decades the Residents of Teller & Gilpin Counties have Not Been Appointed to the Colorado Limited Gaming Control Commission.

**New Seven-Member Limited Gaming Control Commission Includes:**

- 1) One Certified Law Enforcement Officer (5-Years Experience)
- 2) One Colorado Bar Regulatory Law Attorney (5-Years Experience)
- 3) One Corporate Finance Public Accountant (5-Years Experience)
- 4) One Management-Level Business Member (5-Years Experience)
- 5) **One Registered Elector from a County Other than Gilpin or Teller County that is Not Employed in Gaming Profession or Industry**
- 6) **One Registered Elector from Teller County that May be Employed in the Gaming Profession or Industry**
- 7) **One Registered Elector from Gilpin County that May be Employed in the Gaming Profession or Industry**

**Residency:** "A MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION SERVING PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (1)(a) OF THIS SECTION AS A REGISTERED ELECTOR OF GILPIN OR TELLER COUNTY MAY LIVE WITH HIS OR HER FAMILY IN THE CITY OF CENTRAL, BLACK HAWK, OR CRIPPLE CREEK OR IN GILPIN OR TELLER COUNTY, AND MAY OWN PRIVATE PROPERTY IN THOSE AREAS FOR RESIDENTIAL PURPOSES;"

**Solution:** **New Seven-Member Limited Gaming Control Commission with Two New Member Appointments from Teller and Gilpin County.**
