

HB25-1055 be amended as follows:

Amend printed bill, page 2, strike lines 13 and 14 and substitute:

"**SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 18-12-401.5, **amend** (1)(a), (2)(b)(II), (2)(c)(I), (4)(c)(II) as follows:

18-12-401.5. Permit required - issuing agency - cash fund - inspections - penalty - report - rules - repeal. (1) (a) Beginning July 1, ~~2025~~ **2026**, every dealer must obtain a state permit in order to engage in the business of dealing in firearms other than destructive devices in this state.

(2) (b) (II) (A) The department's initial rules promulgated pursuant to this subsection (2)(b) must be effective no later than February 1, ~~2025~~ **2026**.

(B) This subsection (2)(b)(II) is repealed, effective July 31, ~~2025~~ **2026**.

(c) (I) The fee for a state permit issued on or before June 30, ~~2026~~ **2027**, is four hundred dollars. The department shall annually review the fee and, for permits issued on and after July 1, ~~2026~~ **2027**, may annually adjust the fee based on the costs for administering this section. The department shall not adjust the fee more than once each year and shall not adjust the fee by more than twenty-five dollars each year.

(4) (c) (II) (A) A dealer who submits a sufficient application on or before May 2, ~~2025~~ **2026**, may continue to engage in the business of dealing in firearms pursuant to state law until the department has acted upon the application. For the purposes of this subsection (4)(c)(II), an application is sufficient if it includes on its face information necessary to show that the applicant is eligible for a state permit.

(B) This subsection (4)(c)(II) is repealed, effective June 30, ~~2026~~ **2027**.

SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 18-12-407 **amend as it will become effective July 1, 2025**, (5) as follows:

18-12-407. Dealer employee requirements - background check - penalty - repeal. (5) (a) Notwithstanding the requirement in subsection (1) of this section, a person employed by a dealer on July 1, ~~2025~~ **2026**, who submits fingerprints for a background check pursuant to subsection (3) of this section before July 8, 2025, may continue employment without the results of a background check until the department determines whether the employee is qualified for employment pursuant to this section following the background check.

(b) This subsection (5) is repealed, effective December 31, ~~2025~~ **2026**.

SECTION 4. In Session Laws of Colorado 2024, **amend** section 7 of chapter 492 as follows:

Section 7. **Effective date.** This act takes effect upon passage; except that sections 3, 4, and 5 of this act take effect July 1, ~~2025~~ **2026**."
