Committee on Health & Insurance.

HB21-1276 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 5, strike lines 13 through 15.

2 Reletter succeeding paragraphs accordingly.

3 Page 10, after line 20 insert:

4 "SECTION 8. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-30-114, amend  
5 (1)(a) as follows:

6 **12-30-114. Demonstrated competency - opiate prescribers -**  
7 **rules - definition.** (1) (a) The applicable licensing board for each  
8 licensed health-care provider, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE CENTER FOR  
9 RESEARCH INTO SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER PREVENTION, TREATMENT, AND  
10 RECOVERY SUPPORT STRATEGIES CREATED IN SECTION 27-80-118, shall  
11 promulgate rules that require each licensed health-care provider, as a  
12 condition of renewing, reactivating, or reinstating a license on or after  
13 October 1, ~~2019~~ 2022, to complete up to four credit hours of training per  
14 licensing cycle in order to demonstrate competency regarding: Best  
15 practices for opioid prescribing, according to the most recent version of  
16 the division's guidelines for the safe prescribing and dispensing of  
17 opioids; THE POTENTIAL HARM OF INAPPROPRIATELY LIMITING  
18 PRESCRIPTIONS TO CHRONIC PAIN PATIENTS; BEST PRACTICES FOR  
19 PRESCRIBING BENZODIAZEPINES; recognition of substance use disorders;  
20 referral of patients with substance use disorders for treatment; and the use  
21 of the electronic prescription drug monitoring program created in part 4  
22 of article 280 of this title 12."

23 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

24 Page 12, strike lines 8 through 27.

25 Page 13, strike lines 1 and 2.

26 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

27 Page 17, line 26, strike "16" and substitute "15".

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
