**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Assessment of Proposed Amendment **House Bill 21-1300\_L.002**

This memorandum is an assessment of the fiscal impact of the attached proposed amendment L.002 to HB21-1300. This fiscal assessment is for the impact of the bill with inclusion of this amendment only. Any other added amendment could influence the fiscal impact.

### **Summary of Proposed Amendment**

Amendment L.002 eliminates the bill provision allowing health care provider lien holders to file liens with the Secretary of State. Following this, it also eliminates associated provisions establishing priority for liens filed with the state, and in cases where multiple such liens are filed with the state, priority for liens with earlier filing dates.

### **Fiscal Impact of Amendment**

With the adoption of Amendment L.002, the Secretary of State's revenue and expenditure impacts are eliminated. Costs to update systems and receive health care provider lien filings are rendered unnecessary, and the \$8 filing fees would not be collected by the department.

### **Bill's Revised Fiscal Impact with Amendment**

The bill is assessed as having a minimal fiscal impact to multiple state agencies and no appropriation is required.
